Drew and Jack were separated by just 0.01 points headed into the Summer's final week. Drew had 14.71 to Jack's 14.70. And, the two were scheduled to face off (for just the second time in the season) on the final

week. Alas, Jack had to get a sub (freezing his rating at 14.70, and Drew dominated on the top court, ballooning his rating to 15.03. Ratings in the Summer are typically squashed somewhat due to the frequent use of just 4 courts.
