Congratulations, for the 4th season in a row to **Tim** as the winner of this past season's Urshan Award. Congratulations too to **Jack** as a silver medal winner. Their 0.07-point difference was the closest finish in the last 10 years. And, #s 3, 4, and 5 (Doug, Ben, and David) were just behind.

Points are based on a system that tracks wins and losses giving higher credit for higher courts. The stats of subs don't count toward the points for each player. So whether you had a sub, or you served as a sub, those points don't affect your season points results. [FYI, if you're really curious about this, I do have ratings and results available that include "as-a-sub" results.]
